### The New Evangelization:

Preparing the Good News with Joy, Zeal, and Renewed Spirit

- Organize and present a series of workshops to identify new ministers and maintain active participation in liturgical ministries which will result in adding at least 30 new ministers (primarily Eucharistic Ministers and Hospitality) by Jul. 2017.
- Establish a ministry of outreach and service to senior members of our community by Jun. 2017.
- Promote and support Small Church Communities (SCCs) and establish 10 new groups by Jun. 2018.
- Assess and reorganize bereavement ministry by Dec. 2016.



# Catechesis and Formation:

Growing in our Faith and Knowledge of Jesus Christ

- Review every level of catechetical programs in the parish by Jan. 2017.
- Identify and provide for education and training of 10–15 individuals for service in child & youth catechesis and 10–15 individuals in adult catechesis by Mar. 2017.
- Plan and provide 4 additional retreat experiences annually by Jun. 2018.
- Organize and present at least 5 talks to enrich sacramental marriages by Jun. 2017.



### Youth and Young Adults: Emerging Disciples of Christ

- Sponsor and promote Young Adult ministry and have at least 30 members of the parish participating by Jul. 2017.
- Increase formation processes for our middle schoolers, teens, and young adults by Jul. 2017.
- Include the parish's youth actively and visibly in the life of the parish by securing at least 3 lectors, 12 hospitality, 10 Communion Ministers and 15 choir members by Jun. 2017.
- Promote attendance at Archdiocesan youth and young adult events by Oct. 2016.
